TITLE: Bert Mason Humanitarian Award

Centennial Project Area if applicable: Other

Synopsis of Project:

The award is for Lions, Lionesses and Leos who have served Lionism for at least a year and a day and must have given exceptional service for humanitarian needs before they can be recommended for the award.

Over the next two years it is planned to promote this award to clubs and Districts so that at least 200 individuals can be recognised for their outstanding humanitarian commitment.

How 2 Guide:

- 1 An application form for the award may be downloaded from the MD website.
- 2 Nominations for the award can come from Lions groups in MD105 such as a Club, a Zone, a Region, a District or the Multiple District.
- 3 The nomination form must be completed in full and include a citation.
- 4 Nominations coming from within a district shall be assessed by the District Governor Team and/or the Cabinet. In the case of a nomination coming from the Multiple District the assessment shall be made by the Chairperson of Council and the Council of Governors.
- 5 The award comprises a medal showing the bell as used in Past President Bert Mason's logo with a purple and gold ribbon, with the name of the recipient engraved on it, a certificate incorporating the Lions logo and the bell and pin.
- 6 If approved then the signed application form together with the appropriate fee should be sent to MDHQ for processing. The current cost is £320 which includes £70 administration costs. Cheques should be made payable to Lions Clubs International, MD105 and endorsed on the back, Bert Mason Humanitarian Award.
