## The Bert Mason Memorial Trophy for Service to Youth

### Definition

This Trophy is to be awarded to any Lion or LEO who, in the past 36 months (3 years), has made an outstanding contribution to a Club's or District's work with young people.

### Judging

Each District Governor shall nominate one Lion or LEO from their District for the award, such nominee not to have received the trophy within the past three years. The citations will be judged by PID Geoff Leeder, PID Howard Lee and PID Phil Nathan MBE.

### Presentation

The Trophy is to be presented annually at the MD105 Convention.

### Suggested Qualities

At all times, has shown an affinity with and respect for young people, and

- Has shown enthusiasm for, and/or commitment to, youth projects within their Club and/or District, and/or
- Has introduced new youth projects to their Club and/or District, and/or
- Has increased involvement in and success of existing youth projects within their Club and/or District, and/or
- Has enthused others to join in with youth projects, and/or
- Through youth projects, has spread awareness of Lionism in their Community and/or District.
